APPLICATION:

Remove old caulking/sealant. Surface must be clean, dry & free from dirt, dust, grease, oil, mildew, wax, loose paint, frost, & other residue or material that may interfere with adhesion. Clip off tip of nozzle/spout @ 45° angle to desired bead size. Load cartridge into caulking gun and apply. Smooth caulk using a Caulk Smoother, Putty Knife or Damp Cloth. Remove excess with a damp cloth before surface skins over.

FOR BEST RESULTS:

- · Apply only in well ventilated areas.
- Do not store or use around heat, open flame.
- Store product at or below 80°F.
- Do not use for joints subject to heavy abrasion or wear.
- Prime bare surfaces before caulking.

CLEAN UP:

Use Mineral Spirits Before Cure.

- Not for use in areas for complete submersion (pool, hot tub, aquarium, marine applications).
- Not recommended for adhering mirrors.
- Not recommended for use in window glazing applications.
