

## 0365/0366 Patching Plaster:

- What is the base chemistry of Patching Plaster? Calcium Sulfate.
- Is Patching Plaster VOC Compliant? Yes, product is suitable for sale in California & OTC areas.
- Are any Prop 65 ingredients added to this product? No.
- What color is Patching Plaster as supplied? White.
- What consistency is Patching Plaster as supplied? Powder.
- **Can Patching Plaster be sanded?** Yes, when fully cured/hardened. For sanding, an appropriate respirator is recommended.
- Is Patching Plaster considered toxic? Product considered non-toxic when used as directed.
- How long should it take for an initial firm set to take place after mixing? Approximately 2 hrs depending on conditions.
- How long before full cure? Approximately 3 to 4 hrs depending on conditions.
- **Can Patching Plaster be painted?** Yes, after complete cure, with either latex or oil based paint.
- What mixing ratio should be used to achieve an "average consistency"? Approximately 3 ½ parts powder to 1 part clean cool water.
