0583 Caulk Remover - Liquid:

- What is the base chemistry of 0583? Proprietary blend.
- **Is Caulk Remover VOC Compliant?** Yes. Product suitable for sale in California & OTC areas.
- Are any Prop 65 Ingredients added during the formulation of this product?
- What is the appearance & odor of 0583? Product is a cream-like fluid, off-white in color, with a mild ester odor.
- Is 0583 considered flammable? No. Product exhibits a flash point of > 225F.
- Is 0583 suitable for interior or exterior use? Yes.
- Does the product work on various types of caulk? Yes.
- How does the product work? It softens caulk for easy removal.
- **Is 0583 decidedly acidic or alkaline?** No product exhibits basically a neutral pH @ approximately 7.0 similar to water.
- **How should product be used?** Apply product directly to surface of caulk to be removed.
- Are there "general" directions for individuals unfamiliar with liquid caulk remover? Yes. Caulk Remover should be stored above freezing. Apply product when material, air temperature & surface are 40F to 90F, applying approximately a 1/8th inch coat to cured caulk to be removed & allow to soften caulk (typically a minimum of 2 hrs) some caulks such as Acrylics may require up to 7 hrs to soften. When caulk has softened considerably, use a putty knife to remove as much as possible. Apply a 2nd application & repeat as required especially for painted caulk. Carefully remove remaining film with a razor blade, taking care not to damage surface. Clean & dry the substrate prior to application of new/replacement caulk. Caulk Remover should remain sealed & stored in a cool dry location when not in use.
